

The Vancouver United Ostomy Association Award

Description of Award

The Vancouver United Ostomy Association Chapter ET (Enterostomal Therapy) award of \$1500.00 shall be awarded annually (pending funding availability) to recognize a BC ET who has demonstrated a high degree of volunteerism with, and support of, people in the Vancouver, lower mainland or province of BC area living with an ostomy.

Objectives

To recognize volunteerism by an ET Nurse that “gives back” to the ostomy community in the Vancouver, lower mainland or province of BC area.

Administration of the Award

This award will be administered by CAET in cooperation with the Vancouver United Ostomy Chapter awards committees. Applications will be reviewed by and winners decided by the Vancouver United Ostomy Chapter. The award will be presented at the CAET Annual Conference. The recipient does not need to be in attendance to win the award.

How to Apply

The Applicant must submit an essay (up to 2000 words, may include pictures) describing their thoughts on and approach to volunteerism and their extracurricular, unpaid, work with people living with an ostomy in the Vancouver, lower mainland or province of BC area.

All essays become the property of the Vancouver United Ostomy Association Chapter and may be published in any Chapter materials

The Applicant:

- Must be a member of CAET.
- Must be a graduate of CAET ETNEP program.
- Must be selected by the Vancouver United Ostomy Association Chapter awards committee.
- Must give permission and provide a photo and background story to be published in the CAET LINK or Vancouver United Ostomy Association Chapter newsletters.

All applications must be submitted by email to director@caetacademy.ca and received by December 31 of the year prior to the awarding (Except for the year 2017, see NOTE below)

- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- Only award winners will be contacted
- The award will be mailed to the recipient
- The award may only be won once

NOTE

For the 2017-year award, applications will be received up to April 15 2017 to be eligible for awards to be given at the 2017 CAET Conference in London, Ontario.
